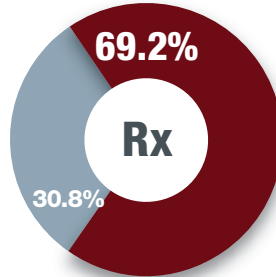


Total Market Size and Total Cost

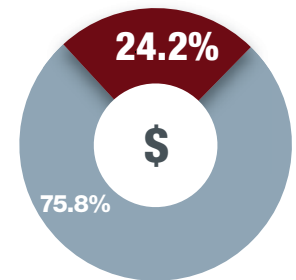
Generic medicine accounts for 69.2% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2015. This equates to **11 million prescriptions.**

Generic medicine represents **only 24.2%** of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$167 million while **brand-name drugs cost \$523 million.**

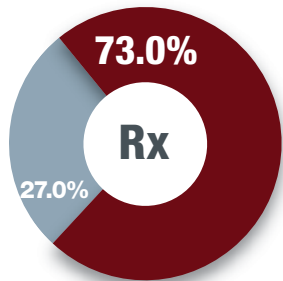

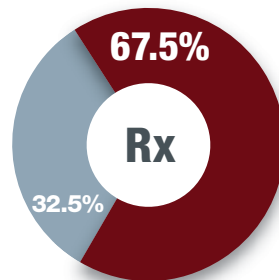


Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines

Public sector use of generic medicine is significantly greater than in the private sector.

For every one percent increase in the use of generic medicine, Saskatchewan would have saved **\$11,000,000** in 2015.
