

## **Total Market Size and Total Cost**

Generic medicine accounts for 66.7% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to 36.2 million prescriptions.

**Generic medicine represents** only 22.3% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$656 million while brand-name drugs cost \$2.3 billion.



## **Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines**



Public sector use of generic medicine is significantly greater than in the private sector.

For every one percent increase in the use of generic medicine. **British Columbia would have** saved \$40,000,000 in 2016.
