

Total Market Size and Total Cost

Generic medicine accounts for 69.1% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to 8.8 million prescriptions.

Generic medicine represents only 24.9% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$159 million while brand-name drugs cost \$481 million.




Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines
