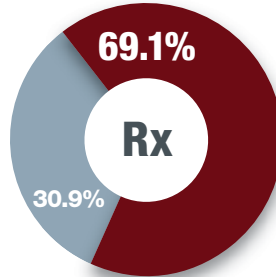


Total Market Size and Total Cost

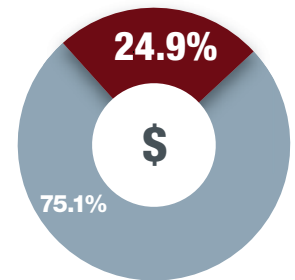
Generic medicine accounts for 69.1% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to **8.8 million prescriptions**.

Generic medicine represents **only 24.9%** of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$159 million while **brand-name drugs cost \$481 million**.

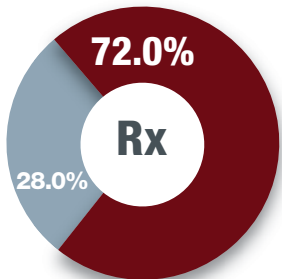

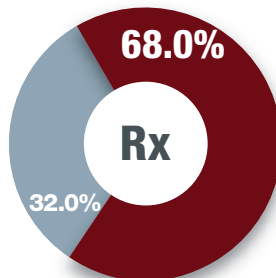


Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines
