

## **Total Market Size and Total Cost**

Generic medicine accounts for 69.1% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to 9.0 million prescriptions.


**Generic medicine represents** only 25.9% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$197 million while brand-name drugs cost \$563 million.

**Public sector use of generic** medicine is significantly greater than in the private sector.

For every one percent increase in the use of generic medicine, **Nova Scotia would have saved** \$12,400,000 in 2016.
