

Market Size and Cost

Generic medicine accounts for 70.6% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2017. This equates to 474 million prescriptions.

Generic medicine represents only 21.8% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$6 billion while brand-name drugs cost \$21.5 billion.



Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines



Public sector use of generic medicine is significantly greater than in the private sector.

For every one percent increase in the use of generic medicine, Canada would have saved \$526,500,000 in 2017.
