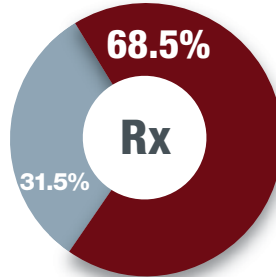


Total Market Size and Total Cost

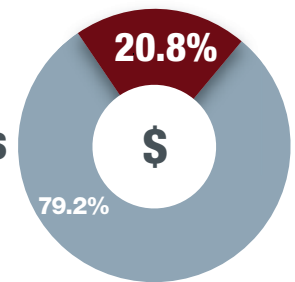
Generic medicine accounts for 68.5% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to 142 million prescriptions.

Generic medicine represents only 20.8% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$2.1 billion while brand-name drugs cost \$8.2 billion.

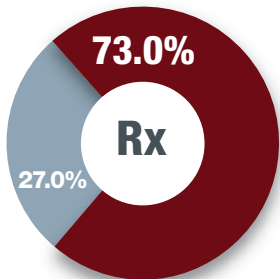

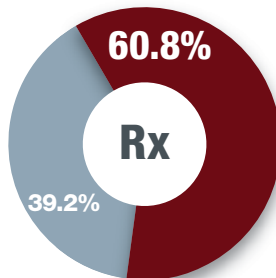


Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines

For every one percent increase in the use of generic medicine, Ontario would have saved \$195,000,000 in 2016.
