

## **Total Market Size and Total Cost**

Generic medicine accounts for 67.1% of all retail prescriptions filled in 2016. This equates to 7.7 million prescriptions.

Generic medicine represents only 28.0% of the total market cost. Generic drugs account for \$147 million while brand-name drugs cost \$378 million.






## **Percentage Usage of Generic Medicines**


